BOREHAM LIBRARY FACULTY COMMITTEE MEETING
January 30, 2006

The faculty library committee met on January 30, 2006 in Room 202 of the library.

The first topic on the agenda was a discussion of possible extended hours for the library. It was decided that a survey would be constructed and given to several classes and those using the library and the campus center.

Wilma Cunningham shared information on the Library Budget Request for 2006. The major items requested were funding for databases for Criminal Justice and Sociology, and Ref Works for use by students and faculty writing papers. An additional \$25,000 was requested for the book budget.

Elizabeth Momand reported that we could cancel the Groves Online Music database for the present time due to low usage statistics. She asked library staff to meet with the music consultant who will be visiting soon.

Cammie Sublette requested Philosopher's Index be considered.

A subscription for Federated searching will be evaluated this next year.

The committee members are each working to add to their library collections some titles found in using the new collection development software. Graphics design faculty reviewed a Core Collection list and recommended titles. Business and music faculty are in the process of evaluating their areas.

Library staff would like to present at fall in-service on the new RefWorks database if possible. Wilma will ask about this possibility.

Committee meetings will be changed to 3:00 p.m. instead of 2:00 p.m. each month.
